


Becoming a faithful steward of God's abundant blessings, enables us to experience the joy of giving. The discipline of stewardship suggests that we "give until it feels good".

Discovering God's will for our lives and resources is an opportunity for spiritual growth and a deepening of our relationship with God.




2020 (Jan-Sept.) Income and Expense
